General RPGA Information

The reduced seminar fee for the Reid open registration three-day seminar on The Reid Technique of Interviewing and Interrogation is \$395 - a savings of \$155 from the standard \$550 per person fee and \$570 for the full Four-Day Program (Three-Day Regular plus One-Day Advanced)- a savings of \$180 from the standard \$750 per person fee.
